The Air Force Sergeants Association (AFSA), Kittyhawk Chapter 751 is once again hosting a raffle fundraiser. Our fundraising endeavor will not only provide support for our chapter but will bring in as much as \$6,600 for both the Dayton Veteran's Administration campus and the Dayton Fisher Nightingale House Inc. We respectfully request your consideration in buying one or several raffle tickets, donating support directly to this effort, and or pledging to sponsor an entire facet of the raffle finale event.

Last year's raffle event was on 18 March 2016. It was a St. Patrick's themed dinner & casino event, attended by over 200 people from the local community. There were 10 individual raffle winners who received \$3,355.00 and a total of \$2,685 was donated to the Dayton Veteran's Administration campus and the Dayton Fisher Nightingale House Inc. combined.

Our next raffle fundraiser will be on 7 October 2017, which will be a pirate themed dinner & casino event. Tickets for the raffle fundraiser itself are \$50 each. Tickets for the dinner event are \$32 each, however, you do not need to be present to win a prize. Provided we sell all 400 tickets, the grand prize will be worth \$3,000 and there will be 28 other cash prizes drawn during the evening's festivities.

There are many ways to support our raffle event. Those who donate monetarily will have the option to have a custom felt top made for a casino table in addition to being added to our sponsor recognition mural. Custom felt table covers will be used every year, in which a sponsor participates, until all table positions are full, at which time a rotation system will be utilized. Another way to support the raffle fundraiser is to purchase one or many raffle tickets for \$50 each. We are also accepting donations of gift certificates or gift bags for door prizes to be utilized during the dinner event.

Here is who we are and a little of what we do. The Air Force Sergeants Association represents 100,000 members by advocating for their interests to America's elected and military leaders.
