 - Diverse Portfolio: Automatic Test Systems, Portfolio Analysis, FMS, Air Force Metrology & Calibration, Simulators, Human Systems, Electronic Warfare and Avionics, Support Equipment and Vehicles





- Business Enterprise Systems (BES)
 - AFLCMC/HI office symbol
 - Acquires & Sustains Enterprise Information Technology (IT)
 - HQ at Maxwell AFB Gunter Annex in Alabama
 - Buying/Program Mgt Offices at WPAFB
- Fighters and Advanced Aircraft
 - AFLCMC/WA office symbol
 - Acquires & Sustains Fighter and Advanced Aircraft systems
 - Includes Attack Systems, Advanced Aircraft, A-10, F-35, F-16, F-15, F-22A
 - HQ at WPAFB; Other program offices at Hill AFB, UT;
 Robins AFB, GA; Tinker AFB, OK; Crystal City, VA





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Bombers

- AFLCMC/WB office symbol
- Acquires & Sustains Bomber systems
- Includes B-1, B-2, B-52, Strike Systems
- HQ at WPAFB; Other program offices at Tinker AFB, OK
- Intelligence, Surveillance, Reconnaissance & Special Operations Forces (ISR/SOF)
 - AFLCMC/WI office symbol
 - Acquires & Sustains ISR/SOF Solutions
 - HQ at WPAFB; other program offices at Robins AFB, GA





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Mobility & Training Aircraft

- AFLCMC/WL office symbol
- Acquires & Sustains Mobility & Training Aircraft
- Includes C-130, C-17, C-5, JPATS Trainer, KC-46 and Legacy Tanker
- HQ at WPAFB; Other program offices at Hill AFB, UT;
 Robins AFB, GA; Tinker AFB, OK

Presidential and Executive Airlift

- AFLCMC/WV office symbol
- Acquires and sustains presidential, executive, and special mission aircraft
- Includes VC-25A & VC-25B, C-12, C-21, C-32, C-37, C-40, and E-4B
- HQ at WPAFB; Other program office at Tinker AFB, OK





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Rapid Sustainment Office

- AFLCMC/RO office symbol
- HQ at WPAFB
- Increase mission readiness by rapidly identifying, applying and scaling technology essential to the operation and sustainment of the USAF
- 4 Focus Areas: Agile Manufacturing, Artificial Intelligence, Automation + Robotics, and Augmented + Virtual

Propulsion

- AFLCMC/LP office symbol
- HQ at Tinker AFB, OK
- Provides contract support for Engine Component Improvement Program and adaptive engine technology for the next generation propulsion system for multiple combat aircraft applications.





- AFLCMC is ~71% of AFMCs total spend
- AFMC is ~74% of USAF total spend
- FY20 AFLCMC spent 44% of AFMC's SB dollars (\$3.6B)

Doing Business with AFLCMC



- Register your business:
 - Obtain a DUNS Number
 - Free of charge for Government Contracting and Grants
 - System for Award Management (SAM)
 - Consolidated system for federal procurement
 - No cost to companies, https://www.sam.gov
- Search for contracting opportunities:
 - Beta.sam.gov, https://beta.sam.gov/
 - Officially replaced FBO



Doing Business with AFLCMC



- Know the rules of Federal Government contracting
 - Keep abreast of changes in laws and regulations
- Submit well-prepared quotes or proposals
- Pointers to Small Businesses:
 - Respond to Sources Sought Synopses
 - Consider teaming in order to strengthen capabilities
 - Consider subcontracting opportunities-perform well



How You Can Help Yourselves



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Why SBs should respond to sources sought, RFIs and/or draft RFPs:

- If the rule of two is met, the Contracting Officer (CO)
 may set aside that contract for restricted competition
- Better market intelligence can allow the CO to make an informed decision regarding:
 - Whether subcontracting opportunities exist
 - What SB goals are reasonable/attainable for the prime
- Formulating a response early on allows more opportunity to communicate with the CO



- The AF is looking for ways to break out larger contracts
 - Allows SBs to compete/prime on part of requirements
 - Must be capable of performing at a fair and reasonable price
- What SB can do to communicate this might be feasible:
 - Respond to sources sought, RFIs and draft RFPs
 - Be sure the information from SAM is accurate and complete
 - Attend Industry Days
 - Even if your capability isn't broken out, you may meet a prime willing to include you on their proposal for the overall effort
